Failure to properly install or use this accessory or follow these warnings and instructions, the instructions provided with your car seat, and the information on the car seat's labels can result in serious injury or death of the child in a sharp turn, sudden stop, or crash.

- Use only with Clek Foonf or Fllo convertible car seats.
- Only use Q-tether when installing Clek Foonf or Fllo convertible car seats rear-facing. NEVER use Q-tether when installing Foonf or Fllo forward-facing.
- Always adjust Q-Tether Connector Strap so that Splitter Plate is located on top of vehicle seat back. NEVER use Q-tether with Splitter Plate in front of vehicle seat back.
- Do not tighten Q-tether more than needed to remove slack.
 Overtightening Q-tether could shift the position of the car seat resulting in a seat too upright.
- Only connect Tether Hook to a designated tether anchor. NEVER connect Tether Hook to an unapproved anchor point.
- Only connect Tether Hook to the tether anchor dedicated for the seating position being used. NEVER connect Tether Hook to an adjacent tether anchor.

Checklist for Proper Use of Q-Tether

IMPORTANT: This is only a checklist – you must read and understand all of the warnings and instructions provided with your Clek car seat and in these instructions before installing or using the Q-Tether.

- Foonf or Fllo is installed rear-facing according to car seat instruction manual.
- ✓ Tether Hook is connected to designated tether anchor.
- Q-Tether Connector Strap is tightened so that Splitter Plate is located on top of vehicle seat back.
- Loops at end of Q-Tether are properly attached to Splitter Plate and completely inside the slot.
- Q-Tether adjuster is located on side of vehicle where child will be loaded and unloaded.
- Q-Tether is correctly routed through both Forward-Facing Belt Lock-offs and both Lock-offs are closed.
- ✓ Q-Tether Strap must not pass between Shoulder Harness Straps
 and back of seat.
- Q-tether webbing is tightened to be snug without lifting or shifting position of car seat.

Vehicle Information

- Tether anchors have been provided in second row seating positions by most vehicle manufacturers since 2001.
- Top tether anchors are found behind the vehicle seat as shown in Figure 1.
- If covered, the tether anchor locations may be identified by a symbol as shown in Figure 2.
- See your vehicle owner's manual to identify what seating positions have a tether anchor.
- See your vehicle owner's manual for instructions on routing and connecting the Tether Hook relative to any vehicle features such as a vehicle headrest.





Q-Tether Features

- 1 Tether Hook
- 2 Q-Tether Connector Adjuster
- 3 Q-Tether Connector Strap
- 4 Splitter Plate
- 5 Q-Tether Attachment Loops
- 6 Q-Tether Adjuster
- 7 Q-Tether Strap



IMPORTANT: Car seat MUST be properly installed according to the instructions in the car seat manual in a vehicle seating position with a designated tether anchor before installing Q-Tether.

Installing Q-Tether

Step 1

Locate tether anchor as shown in Figure 3. If covered, the tether anchor may be identified by a symbol, as shown in Figure 2.

Step 2

Loosen Q-Tether Connector Strap by pressing and holding Q-Tether Connector Adjuster while pulling strap as shown in

Figure 4.

Step 3

Attach Tether Hook to vehicle tether anchor as shown in Figure 5 or 6.







Check that Q-Tether Adjuster is connected to side of Splitter Plate closest to where child will be loaded and unloaded.

Option 1: If Q-Tether Adjuster needs to be moved to other side of Splitter Plate:

- Remove loop at each end of Q-Tether Strap from Splitter Plate by sliding strap out through slot in Splitter Plate as shown in Figure 7.
- Position Q-Tether Strap so that Adjuster is located on side of Splitter Plate closest to where child will be loaded and unloaded.

 Attach loop at end of Q-Tether Strap by sliding looped end into slot in Splitter Plate as shown in Figure 8.

Option 2: If Q-Tether Adjuster is on correct side of Splitter Plate:

 Remove one loop at end of Q-Tether Strap from Splitter Plate by sliding strap out through slot in Splitter Plate as shown in Figure 9.

Step 5

Press and hold Q-Tether Adjuster and pull out on Q-Tether Strap until Strap reaches full length as shown in **Figure 10**.



Open both Forward-Facing Belt Lock-offs as shown in Figure 11.

Step 7

Route looped end of Q-Tether Strap through Forward-Facing Belt Path, taking care that Q-Tether Strap is NOT between the Harness and seat, as shown in Figure 12.



IMPORTANT: Check that Q-Tether Strap is flat and not twisted before attaching loop to Splitter Plate.

Attach loop at end of Q-Tether Strap to Splitter Plate by sliding Strap into slot in Splitter Plate as shown in **Figure 13.**





Pull free end of Q-Tether Connector Strap until Splitter Plate is positioned on top of vehicle seat back as shown in **Figure 14.**

IMPORTANT: To prevent injury to the child in a sudden stop or crash Splitter Plate MUST be positioned on top of vehicle seat back and never in front of vehicle seat back where the child's head could strike as shown in Figure 15. Contact Clek Customer Service at 1-866-656-2462 if unable to obtain correct position of Splitter Plate.



Position Q-Tether Strap so that it passes through both Forward-Facing Belt Lockoffs and pull on free end of Q-Tether Strap to tighten as shown in Figure 16 and 17.

IMPORTANT: NEVER tighten Q-Tether Strap further than needed to remove slack. If rear-facing recline shifts when tightening Q-Tether, too much slack has been removed.

Step 11

Check that Q-Tether Strap is within both Forward-Facing Lock-offs and lock both Forward-Facing Belt Lock-offs as shown in Figure 18.

NOTE: If recline angle shifts when closing Lock-offs, reopen Lock-Offs and loosen Q-Tether Strap a small amount before closing Lock-offs.





Final Check

- ✓ Car seat is installed rear-facing according to instruction manual.
- ✓ Tether Hook is connected to the designated tether anchor.
- Q-Tether Connector Strap is tightened so that Splitter Plate is located on top of vehicle seat back.
- ✓ Loop at each end of Q-Tether Strap is completely inside corresponding slot in Splitter Plate.
- Q-Tether Strap is routed through Forward-Facing Belt Path and not between Shoulder Harness Straps and Car Seat.
- Q-Tether Strap is tightened so that slack is removed without shifting the recline angle of the car seat.
- Q-Tether Strap is positioned in both Forward-Facing Lock-offs and both Forward-Facing Lock-offs are closed.
- ✓ Q-Tether Adjuster is located on side of seat closest to where child will be loaded and unloaded.

Loading/Unloading Child

For ease of loading and unloading, it is recommended that Q-Tether be loosened and then re-tightened each trip.

Loosening Q-Tether

Press and hold Q-Tether adjuster and pull out on Q-Tether Strap until Strap reaches full length as shown in Figure 19.

Tightening Q-Tether

Pull free end of Q-Tether Strap until slack is removed as shown in **Figure 20**.

IMPORTANT: NEVER tighten Q-Tether Strap further than needed to remove slack. If rear-facing recline shifts when tightening Q-Tether, too much slack has been removed
